Contributions or gifts to the NEA Fund for Children and Public Education (NEA-FCPE), U-PAC and/or Local PAC are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax.

U-PAC and Local PAC

U-PAC and L-PAC funds are used to help elect friends of education at the state and local levels.

NEA-FCPE

The National Education Association Fund for Children and Public Education collects voluntary contributions from Association members and uses those contributions for political purposes, including, but not limited to, making contributions to and expenditures on behalf of friends of public education who are candidates for federal office. Contributions to The NEA Fund for Children and Public Education are voluntary; making a contribution is neither a condition of employment nor membership in the Association, and members have the right to refuse to contribute without suffering any reprisal. Although The NEA Fund for Children and Public Education requests an annual contribution of \$15.00, this is only a suggestion. A member may contribute more or less than the suggested amount, or may contribute nothing at all, without it affecting his or her membership status, rights, or benefits in NEA or any of its affiliates.

Contributions or gifts to The NEA Fund for Children and Public Education are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes.

Federal law requires us to use our best efforts to collect and report the name, mailing address, occupation, and name of employer for each individual whose contributions aggregate in excess of \$200 in a calendar year.

Federal law prohibits The NEA Fund for Children and Public Education from receiving donations from persons other than members of NEA and its affiliates, and their immediate families. All donations from persons other than members of NEA and its affiliates, and their immediate families, will be returned forthwith.

CAPITOL CLUB

The UEA Capitol Club is your chance to join a select group of educators who have recognized the importance of being involved politically and financially. Capitol Club members understand that voting is not enough to elect officials who truly “measure up” for children and public education, but that it also takes both time and money.

Capitol Club members contribute at least \$100.00 per year to help elect public education-friendly candidates to office, with at least \$70.00 per year being designated to U-PAC.
